[Course aims]

This course deals with medical ethics, clinical epidemiology. As one of the medical professions, dentists have long subscribed to a body of ethical statements developed primarily for the benefit of patients. As a member of this profession, dentists must recognize their responsibility to patients first, and to self for prevention of medical accidents.

The goals of this course are for the student to be able to:

1. Explain the medical ethics and some examples (euthanasia, death with dignity, surrogacy and cloning).
2. Obtain epidemiologic and molecular biological knowledge and technologies.
3. Explain the pathologic diagnosis employing morphologic approaches.
4. Explain medical welfare.
5. Obtain knowledge of medical accidents.
