[Course aims]

Organize knowledge to implement rehabilitation for dysphagia. Clarify the scientific basis for understanding pathological conditions, evaluation methods, and treatment methods. Acquire practical skills for dysphagia rehabilitation treatment.

[Course objectives]

1. Perform physical assessment of dysphagia
2. A screening test for dysphagia can be performed.
3. The sensitivity and specificity of screening tests for dysphagia can be evaluated.
4. Analysis of detailed examinations of dysphagia (Videofluorography of Swallowing Study, Videoendoscopy of swallowing study) can be performed.
5. Prognostic prediction in dysphagia rehabilitation can be performed.
